The 4th Edition of IEEE Advances in Magnetics (AIM 2023) was held in Moena (Trento), Italy, on 15-18 January 2023. AIM 2023 hosted about 190 participants from all continents, of which about one-half IEEE members. In the three days of the Conference, about 150 contributions were presented, among which 100 oral presentations and 50 poster presentations. Two Plenary Talks were held by Prof. Oliver Gutfleisch from TU Darmstadt (Germany) and Prof. Jordi Sort from Universitat Autònoma de Barcellona (Spain). A tutorial was held by Denis Makarov.
